


Sir Francis Drake was an English pirate and explorer. He set off from Plymouth for Egypt in 1577. But his ships sailed north-west across the Atlantic and he reached South America. They attacked Spanish ships there and took their food. Captain Drake sailed round the continent of South America. He discovered some hills to the south of the Antarctic and South America.

Then he went north and was the first person from Europe to reach the west coast of North America. He **met** Native Americans there. Sir Francis Drake explored a new way home from North America. He was the second captain to sail around the world. He came back home in August, 1588.
